
Tabligh a Daily Effort

- 'Call unto the way Of thy Lord with wisdom and goodly exhortation, and argue with them in a way that is best' (Surah Al-Nahl 16:126)


Ahadith about Tabligh and Spreading the Message of Islam

Meaning of Tabligh


 Tabligh- is to convey spread the Message of Islam in forms of Peace, Love, brotherhood and humanity in a way which makes it clear for others to understand

- If I share information about Ahmadiyyat I will

loose friends



Basics of Starting Tabligh

 Begin with what we have in common with other religions (ex: belief in prophets, books, common practices such as fasting, covering head)

ONE WAY

- Engage in **positive** interfaith communication
- TABLIGH IS NOT A ONEWAY STREET-Make an interactive discussion and ask about their religion. Show interest in their religion and they'll give you opportunity to let you tell them about your religion.
