- One of the most joyous and blessed event in one's life
- ♦ A life-changing event, sometimes stressful
- Fulfillment of "half of one's faith"
 (Hadith)

The Path of Tagwa

- The Nikah (wedding) sermon has three verses, and the word "taqwa" is mentioned five times in the sermon
- The repetition of the word signifies that tagwa is the foundation upon which a harmonious and prosperous marriage is built (The Holy Qur'an 4:2)

"THE RAIMENT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS — THAT IS THE BEST." (7:27)

Steps to a successful marriage

Both partners make it their ultimate goal to achieve the special love of Allah



They safequard their actions and behavior towards each other, and discharge their obligations in the most responsible way



They will be able to build a strong foundation of tagwa, and will inevitably invite the special blessings of Allah upon them

When to tie the knot?

- Marriage is a sunnah of the Holy Prophet (sa) and one aspect
 of fulfilling this practice is to undertake this activity at the
 appropriate time in one's life
- Although Islam grants the individual freedom to pursue personal goals, marriage should always be a priority!

 If our goals and desires do not coincide with Islamic objectives, we will not be able to elevate ourselves to higher spiritual degrees 'WHEN ONE MARRIES, HE FULFILLS HALF OF HIS FAITH" (HADITH)

The Leap of Faith

• TRUST is a critical component of team effectiveness

 It is absolutely vital that both partners have a bond of profound trust between them; otherwise you will not be able to take even one step forward in your marriage

R is for Respect

- In a new marriage, understanding and trust between the partners has yet to be established.
- Mutual respect is fundamental to a successful marriage.
- Part of respect also means to cover each other's weaknesses and never discuss your personal matters with friends and relatives.

Talking It Out...

- · Communication in a new marriage is vital!
- Every family is unique and every household is run a particular way. Give yourself some time to adjust to them, and for them to get to know you.
- Keep the channels of communication open, so that misunderstandings can be avoided

Hand in Hand...

- Obedience and submission to the Will of God are the hallmarks of a Muslim, and are also integral concepts in a marriage
- Roles and duties of husbands and wives are different
- Once someone asked a newly married woman, "who is the head of your household?" She replied, "God is the head of our household".
